

## Stewardship Education Alliance GRANT PROGRAM

## Purpose of Grant:

To support projects, courses, or programs including equipment proposed by teachers that help advance the mission and vision of the Stewardship Education Alliance.

MISSION: To increase community awareness of ways to be better stewards of our local watersheds.

VISION: An educated and engaged community preserving and improving the local watershed.

## **Eligibility:**

Teachers in public and independent schools in the five towns that serve Camden Hills High School are eligible to apply for a grant. These towns include Appleton, Camden, Hope, Lincolnville, and Rockport, Maine.

#### Terms of the Grant:

- 1. Applications that include data collection by students will receive priority
- 2. Grants must not be for expenses covered by taxes
- 3. Grant applications will be reviewed by a committee
- 4. A second committee will review implementation upon completion
- 5. Teachers will be asked to submit a review of what they learned and how they will use it, and to share that information with other teachers
- 6. Teachers and their students will have the opportunity to present work supported by a grant from S.E.A. at S.E.A. FAIR to be held at the Camden Public Library Amphitheater on June 3, 2022
- 7. Teachers must submit the application form online or by email (info@stewardshipeducationalliance.org) by February 28, 2022
- 8. Grants will be awarded by March 22, 2022

# Amount of the Grant:

Most grants will between \$250.00 and \$500.00.
